“Students in Service” is a part-time AmeriCorps program that offers scholarships to college students who participate in community service.

HOW LARGE A SCHOLARSHIP

300 hours of service = \$1,132

450 hours of service = \$1,415

900 hours of service = \$2,675

- Complete the brief online Pre-Service Orientation
- Attend the In-Person Orientation
- Enroll in the program
- Serve your community
- Receive a scholarship!

WHAT ACTIVITIES QUALIFY?

- Academic and co-curricular service-learning
- Non-paid, academic internships with a service-focus
- Practicum hours, such as nursing, counseling, firefighting, student teachers who qualify, etc.
- Community service in the areas of education, public safety, environmental initiatives, community development, and human services
- Federal or State-funded community service work study positions (the only eligible paid positions)
- Most volunteer work, including tutoring, mentoring, stream restoration, volunteer recruitment, etc.
